Terms and Conditions

- Personal effects are not insured by SASC, you are advised to take out your own insurance to cover clothing and possessions. Please do not leave valuables in the changing room.
- It is expected that members will behave with courtesy and consideration towards other club members, disciplinary action may be taken against any member deemed to be behaving in such a way as to cause harm or distress to any member, or damage to property.
- All members must accept responsibility for their own safety and follow the operating procedures of the club.
- Members (and parent/carers, if under 18) should understand and accept that sailing has inherent risks, e.g. risk of drowning, hypothermia, boom strike. Similarly jetties and slipways may pose additional slip or trip hazards. The operating procedures of the club should minimise the risks, however it is essential that members are aware of these and also take responsibility for their own behaviour to minimise risk to themselves and others.
- SASC shall not be liable for any injury, damage or loss which may arise from the normally accepted risks of sailing. Members are advised to take out adequate insurance to cover for injury, loss or medical cover.
- Children under 16 must be supervised at all times by parents/carers. SASC does not accept any responsibility while Juniors are on the premises. Parent/carers must also make the decision as to the suitability of the conditions for their children to sail. Children must not be left unsupervised on shore if parents/carers are sailing unless provision for their care has been made with another appropriate adult.
- All members must comply with SASC Constitution and general rules at all times. Copy available to view on club notice board or website.
- All members are expected to carry out **at least 6 duties per sailing calendar**.
- All members must comply with rules and regulations laid down for use of the water and general conduct by Ashfield District Council.
- All boats must be waterworthy and have required buoyancy.
